Sunday 26 November 2023 : Christ the King

This last Sunday before Advent, the Feast of our Lord Jesus Christ King of the Universe completes our month of reflecting on the Kingdom of God. It is a good opportunity to consider Catholic Social Teaching, which is concerned with how we as the Church live out the Kingdom of God in the world. Social action is a context in which we can work together with other Christians and people of good will towards the common good. Yet Catholic Social Teaching is not just a soft alternative to proclaiming the fulness of the Catholic faith; rather, social teaching and action are integral to the fulness of the Catholic faith. Concern for the environment and a preferential option for the poor only make sense in the light of the dignity and freedom of the human person to which the Gospel of Life gives witness. In our social witness and action, we honour Christ the King by upholding the dignity of all His subjects: the inalienable right to life from conception; the image and likeness of God revealed in the marriage of one man and one woman for life; a preferential option for families and children.
