## Sunday 10 December: Second Sunday of Advent (B)

Today we read the beginning of St Mark's Gospel, "the beginning of the Good News about Jesus Christ" The first thing Mark does is to remind us of Prophet Isaiah's words from our first reading: "Prepare a way for the Lord!" As we continue to reflect of our Bishop's pastoral letter for Advent, let's consider the significance of our faithful celebration of the Sunday Mass, week by week. Our practice of the faith forms a straight way through our lives towards the Lord, and on which the Lord comes to meet us. But if we miss Sunday Mass without good reason, the way becomes broken. The message of John the Baptist is all about the one who is coming, "someone more powerful than I am ... he will baptise you with the Holy Spirit." This is the Lord who comes to meet us at every celebration of the Eucharist. The hymn we sing as we prepare for his imminent arrival, "Holy, Holy, Holy Lord God of Hosts" (cf Isaiah 6) is a sign to us that an immense, tremendous Being has set out and is on His way to us, even as we pray together now. "Behold your God!" "Here is the Lord, coming with power." (Isaiah 40:9-10).
