CAFOD IN OUR PARISH Thank you for your prayers and continuing support for CAFOD in 2023, through your donations (refreshments on Sunday mornings, Taizé, cake sales), weekly envelope collection for our current project, our two Family Fast Days and appeals. We have raised an amazing £4841. Thank you also for all the online donations and direct debits (amount unknown). We started our new two year project "Hands on Karuna Battambag" in Cambodia in January 2022 and raised £2002.97 this year bringing the total to £3463.87. This will help CAFOD's experts on the ground work alongside rice farmers who are struggling because of inconsistent and unreliable weather by introducing them to a new climate-conscious method of planting, growing and harvesting rice, blending traditional knowledge with modern techniques. It will help farmers to grow more reliable crops to feed their families and to sell to earn independent incomes even when times are rough. Many thanks also for your generous response to our TWO FAMILY FAST DAYS: £1895.69 was raised through the envelope collection alone. Your support for THE BIG LENT WALK also raised over £750 to help fight global poverty. Thank you also for your response to the online Turkey-Syria earthquake appeal (amount unknown), the Christmas Appeal for Afghanistan (£92.35 from the cake sale in Advent) and finally, the online donations and the CWL gift of £100 for the Israeli-Palestinian Crisis Appeal. On behalf of our Brothers and Sisters around the world, a huge thank you. Once again, in these difficult times, you helped CAFOD keep the flame of hope burning brightly in some of the hardest to reach corners of the world. But your prayers and financial support are needed more than ever in order to continue protecting and helping the lives of those in poor communities. CONTACTLESS MACHINE AND GIFT AID The DONA contactless machine now accepts Gift aided payments. When you present your card, you are given the option to giftaid or not. If you select yes, then you will be prompted for your name, number of house, and postcode. The Postcode must be entered in UPPER CASE (CAPITALS) LETTERS. Once this has been done, the machine will recognise your card the next time to make a payment and automatically gift aid the transaction. Gift Aid can increase the value of your donations by 25%. CONTACTLESS GIVING To use the contactless machine, you need to wave your card over the small box to the right of the main screen. The machine has options for Sunday Collection, Second Collection, Repository and other collections as the need arises. Donations will show as "SumUp" on bank statements.
