Sunday 25 February 2024 : Second Sunday of Lent

In our first reading today, Abraham hears God acknowledge that Issac is Abraham's "only son", "your only child, whom you love". And yet Abraham is prepared to sacrifice Isaac because he thinks that this is how he is called to worship God. On the way to the place of sacrifice, Abraham assures Isaac that "God himself will provide the lamb for the sacrifice" (Genesis 22:8), but it is only when Isaac is on the altar and Abraham's hand is on the knife that he sees the ram caught by its horns in the thorn bush. In prophecy here, we see the figure of Christ, his head caught in the crown of thorns, who is indeed the Lamb that God provides for the sacrifice. Isaac is returned to Abraham alive (Hebrews 11:19), while God the Father offers instead his only Son, whom he loves: "This is my beloved Son. Listen to him." (Mark 9:7)
