BAPTISMS Due to Fr Kevin's health issues, baptism preparation and therefore baptisms have fallen behind. Despite asking for volunteers to help, no one has come forward to help with these, so baptisms and the associated preparation are delayed. There will be no baptisms until the Easter season. If you do not already have a date you will be contacted in due course, however it is likely these baptisms will not be until May at the earliest.

CLOSER TO CHRIST. This weekend we will introduce the *Closer to Christ* campaign by way of reading Bishop Philip's letter. This campaign seeks to improve communication, foster better accountability and transparency and build on our stewardship of resources. It began in 2021 with a goal to raise £13.5million in pledges to support the furture of our priesthood across the Diocese. This vital fundraising will help priests in three key areas:

- 1. Promoting vocations and enabling our seminiarians to progress towards priesthood
- 2. By providing training and ongoing formation to our active Clergy, of which there are 110 across the Diocese
- 3. Ensuring that our retired priests have access to support and care on reaching the age of 75

Currently, over £11million has been pledged by families right across the Diocese and over the coming weeks we will be inviting parishioners to gatherings to hear more about this undertaking and how they may support it.

CONTACTLESS MACHINE AND GIFT AID The DONA contactless machine accepts Gift aided payments. When you present your card, you are given the option to giftaid or not. If you select yes, then you will be prompted for your name, number of house, and postcode. The Postcode must be entered in UPPER CASE (CAPITALS) LETTERS. Once this has been done, the machine will recognise your card the next time to make a payment and automatically gift aid the transaction. Gift Aid can increase the value of your donations by 25%. CONTACTLESS GIVING To use the contactless machine, you need to wave your card over the small box to the right of the main screen. The machine has options for Sunday Collection, Second Collection, Repository and other collections as the need arises. Donations will show as "SumUp" on bank statements.
