**OUR LADY QUEEN OF PEACE AND BLESSÉD MARGARET POLE CHURCH.** The 27<sup>th</sup> May marks the 60<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the consecration of our church (we will mark this on the 28<sup>th</sup>). In September 1938 the foundation stone was laid and Bishop Cotter (Bishop of Portsmouth) opened and blessed the new church on 24<sup>th</sup> May 1939. On the 27<sup>th</sup> May 1964 Bishop Holland conducted the Solemn Consecration of the church followed by Pontifical High Mass which was celebrated by Archbishop JH King (Bishop of Portsmouth). Originally dedicated to Our Lady Queen of Peace, a second dedication of Blessed Margaret Pole was added at the consecration; the 28<sup>th</sup> May marks the memorial feast day of our co-patron. The land that the church hall sits (previous church) was gifted to the parish, by Reginald Cecil Lybbe Powys-Lybbe, a descendant of Blessed Margaret Pole (Countess of Salisbury). The Countess of Salisbury was beheaded at the orders of Henry VIII and her remains were supposed to be laid to rest at Christchurch Priory. However, Henry refused to allow this and Margaret was interred at the Tower of London in a place reserved for traitors, her crime? being a catholic.

**CONTACTLESS MACHINE AND GIFT AID** The DONA contactless machine now accepts Gift aided payments. When you present your card, you are given the option to giftaid or not. If you select yes, then you will be prompted for your name, number of house, and postcode. The Postcode must be entered in UPPER CASE (CAPITALS) LETTERS. Once this has been done, the machine will recognise your card the next time to make a payment and automatically gift aid the transaction. Gift Aid can increase the value of your donations by 25%. To see a video of how to set up Gift aid please see the following link. Donations will show as "SumUp" on bank statements.

CONTACTLESS GIVING To use the contactless machine, you need to wave your card over the small box to the



right of the main screen. The machine has options for Sunday Collection, Second Collection, Repository and other collections as the need arises. Donations will show as "SumUp" on bank statements.
