## Sunday 5 May 2024 : Sixth Sunday of Easter

In this Sunday's Gospel, we read the continuation of Jesus' Last Supper discourse from John's Gospel. As we hear the Lord talk of love, joy and peace, we cannot fail to be reminded of the fruit of the Holy Spirit, which is surely the living fruit God seeks in his vineyard. As we enter the last weeks of Eastertide, looking towards the Lord's Ascension and his gift of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost, we are reminded that the Holy Spirit forms and convenes the Church. If we are to evangelise our world, to serve others in the name of Christ, to offer the Lord's healing and peace, we can do so only in the power of the Spirit. Let us come together again this week to celebrate <u>Ascension Day this Thursday</u>. Why not follow this up with the ancient practice of praying a novena to the Holy Spirit in preparation for Pentecost?
