Sunday 19 May 2024 : Pentecost Sunday

Pentecost is the great celebration of the Holy Spirit, when we remember the outpouring of the Holy Spirit on the Apostles and the other disciples gathered in the upper room, and pray for a new outpouring of the Holy Spirit in our time and place. The action of the Holy Spirit in our daily lives, especially our prayer and fellowship, should give us courage and confidence to know that we are established, empowered and edified by the Spirit's grace. In every celebration of the Eucharist we call upon the Holy Spirit to sanctify the gifts of bread and wine we bring to the altar, so that they may become the presence of Christ in our midst. We name this calling-down of the Holy Spirit the epiclesis. But every Mass also calls down the Holy Spirit upon the people of God assembled there (the "major epiclesis") – we ask that the Holy Spirit gather us into the Church, and form us into the Body of Christ in unity and peace.
