Eucharist is a word with more than one meaning. It can mean the Mass, the liturgical celebration of the Lord's Supper by which we make present Christ's sacrificial self-offering on the Cross to God the Father, and by which Christ himself comes among us gathered in His name. It can also mean the sacrament of Holy Communion, the Bread of Life which is the Body of Christ under the form of real food, which we eat in obedience to His own command, and by which we share in the life He won for us by the Paschal Mystery of His Death and Resurrection. Eucharist can be something we do, or something we have. We do Eucharist in order to have Eucharist. But above all, surely Eucharist must be something we are. We saw recently that the goal of the Eucharist is Holy Communion – the purpose of celebrating and receiving the Eucharist is to transform us, to make new people out of us. We should hope and pray to be moved by every Mass - moved on in our journey with Christ to ever-closer union.
