CHILDREN'S LITURGY Sunday 9:30 Mass. For safeguarding purposes parents are reminded that children need to be signed in before Mass starts; thank you. This will be the last Children's liturgy until the new school term. We would like to **invite all the children and their families** to come to the church hall, after Mass, to have a drink and some treats.

THIS SUNDAY IS SEA SUNDAY, and we pray for all seafarers and our chaplains from the Stella Maris who work with them. This year's Gospel for Sea Sunday (Mark 6: 7-13) emphasises the importance of service and hospitality for strangers as a sign of Christ's love. In this reading, Jesus instructed the disciples to take almost nothing with them - so they had to rely on the providence of God on their travels - and the generosity of the people they would stay with on the journey. When seafarers arrive in a foreign port, they are strangers, often thousands of miles from home. Stella Maris' chaplains and volunteer ship visitors welcome them, listen to their concerns, and help provide what they need. The Stella Maris teams answer Jesus' call to give hospitality to the stranger. They put their faith into action. To find out more, <https://stellamaris.org.uk/seasunday/>. *****NEW CONTACTLESS MACHINE AND GIFT AID** We have had to replace our **Dona** contactless machine. The new system is via Stripe payments. If you had set up gift aid on the old machine, you will be asked to re-enter your details. Once this is done, it will not need repeating. You will be prompted for your name, number of house, and postcode which should be done in upper case. Once this has been done, the machine will recognise your card the next time to make a payment and automatically gift aid the transaction. Gift Aid can increase the value of your donations by 25%. Payments may appear on bank statements as 'Stripe'. To see a video of how to set up Gift aid please see the following [link](#).

CONTACTLESS GIVING To use the contactless machine, you need to wave your card over the small box to the right of the main screen. The machine has options for Sunday Collection, Second Collection, Repository and other collections as the need arises. Donations will show as "SumUp" on bank statements.
