Sunday 7 July 2027 : Fourteenth Sunday of the Year

This Sunday presents us with the intriguing and mysterious Gospel of the Lord's rejection by the people of his own home town. We are told that he could do no miracle there due to their lack of faith, but the same text mentions that the people specifically asked about the significance of the miracles Jesus performed, and that Jesus did in fact heal some sick people by laying his hands on them. What, then, was the miracle that he would have performed for them but for their lack of faith? This question should cause us to wonder about what God might want to do for us, if only we would let him. The Lord constantly acts in response to those who express their faith in him, such as the woman healed by just touching the fringe of his garment, or the parents who believe he can revive their child. What might we ask of Him?
