Sunday 14 July 2024 : Fifteenth Sunday of the Year

At the end of our Gospel this Sunday there is a small detail it might be easy to overlook: the Apostles "anointed many sick people with oil and cured them" (Mark 6:13). Here we find the beginning of the Sacrament of the Sick, which the Church celebrates for those who are seriously ill or living in advanced old age by praying over them and anointing them with the Oil of the Sick, consecrated by the Bishop in Holy Week. Your priests regularly celebrate this sacrament in our Hospital, in the nursing homes and hospice, in the homes of parishioners, and in church. If you are ill in mind or body, or if you are going to have an operation, or if you find yourself in hospital, please do not hesitate to request this sacrament from a Catholic chaplain. Also, if you know someone who ought to receive anointing of the sick, please let your priests know, so that we can visit them, especially if they are in a care home.
