TRAINING REQUIREMENTS FOR PARISH VOLUNTEERS - SAFEGUARDING

All volunteers in roles that require a DBS certificate are reminded that they should undertake the appropriate online training provided by the Diocese of Portsmouth, every two years. Please contact Mary Basing, Parish Safeguarding Representative by email or telephone (<u>safeguarding.southb@portsmouthdiocese.org.uk</u> or 07969 120264) to be provided with a link to the necessary online training. Some face to face training sessions will be available later in the year. These sessions are not mandatory and do not replace the need for online training. DONA CONTACTLESS MACHINE. If the machine fails to accept your **contactless** card payment, then please insert the card and complete the transaction by pin. This should be indicated on the screen. Contactless payments by mobile phone should not be affected.

CONTACTLESS MACHINE AND GIFT AID The new system is via Stripe payments. If you had set up gift aid on the old machine, you will be asked to re-enter your details. Once this is done, it will not need repeating. You will be prompted for your name, number of house, and postcode which should be done in upper case. Once this has been done, the machine will recognise your card the next time to make a payment and automatically gift aid the transaction. Gift Aid can increase the value of your donations by 25%. Payments may appear on bank statements as 'Stripe'. To see a video of how to set up Gift aid please see the following link.

CONTACTLESS GIVING To use the contactless machine, you need to wave your card over the small box to the right of the main screen. The machine has options for Sunday Collection, Second Collection, Repository and other collections as the need arises. Donations will show as "Stripe" on bank statements.
