Year B (Psalter Week 1)

Welcome to St Patrick's Church. God our Father showed His love for us by sending His Son into the world, not to be served but to serve. Jesus went on to show God the Son's love for us by giving His life in atonement for our sins. Jesus is our high priest and the sacrificial lamb. He has gone through to the highest heaven but not before experiencing the depth of human suffering.
