Year B (Psalter Week 4)

Welcome to St Patrick's Church. This Sunday we hold our Annual Act of Remembrance, in Union with the rest of the United Kingdom and the whole Commonwealth of Nations. From His Majesty the King to the private individual all of us come together, as one, to honour and give thanks for those who, following the example of Jesus, gave their lives so that we may live. For many it may seem somewhat like the "widow's mite" in today's Gospel reading– but every life is precious and every life a treasure and to give one's life is to give all that we have.


