## THIRTY-THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

17th November 2024 AD

Year B (Psalter Week 1)

Welcome to St Patrick's Church. This Sunday our readings remind us that the Son of Man, Jesus Christ, is coming again in glory and power. Jesus died for us all upon the cross and then took His place at the right hand of the Father. This is all part of God's plan for our salvation and we constantly seek to worship God and to call others into His presence. We do this through having a place to gather as the 'people of God' and to be a symbol of His presence on Hayling Island. This week we are going to think about how this is maintained, both spiritually and in practical terms.

**We still need some volunteers to help us sell tea and coffee.**



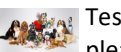

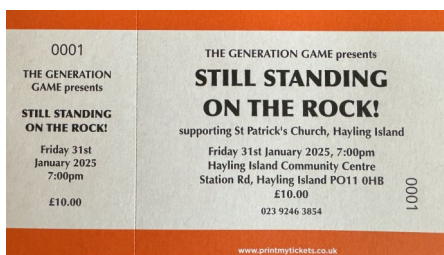
